

Trauma Safety Strap for Harness

CSK001

Anti-trauma safety straps are designed to prevent suspension trauma (orthostatic intolerance) in the event of a fall. When a person remains suspended in the air, even for a short period, the harness can exert pressure on the legs, resulting in loss of consciousness and/or serious injury. They enable suspended workers to stand up in the event of a fall, and keep the body upright to relieve pressure on the legs while waiting for help to arrive.

Easily attached to most harnesses.

2 zip pockets for quick and easy deployment

The straps are adjustable to fit any size.

Compact and lightweight. Does not interfere with worker activity

- 1. Open the pockets on both sides of the harness
 - 2. Connect the end of the strap to the ring and make sure the buckle is in place, locked and secure.

1" nylon webbing 2 pockets Steel components

Size

One size - Adjustable length

Use

Helps maintain good blood circulation in the legs after a fall.



4. Adjust the strap to eliminate strangulation and maintain a sitting position

3. Place foot inside the loop.

Installation instructions



Install Trauma Strap immediately above where leg straps meet side/ shoulder straps (as shown).



Pass Trauma Strap web loop behind harness strap and pull back around.



Pull Trauma Strap pouch through web loop and choke down to harness strap. Pouch must be on outside of harness strap



Secure Trauma Strap snap buckle around harness strap.

Maintenance and Inspection

Maintenance

Clean after each use to maintain safety and durability. Use mild soap and water, then rinse and dry. To dry completely, unroll the strap and hang it up. NEVER clean the strap with corrosive substances. When not in use, store in a place where it will not be affected by heat, light, excessive humidity, chemicals or other degrading elements.

Inspection

Before EACH use, inspect the anti-trauma safety strap for damage. If you find any defects or damage, remove the strap from service IMMEDIATELY.

A competent person should inspect the equipment at least every twelve months.
