Care Guide

A good way to keep leather boots longer is to clean them regularly.

- To start, take off the laces and clean with hot water and a shoe brush removing dirt
- · Remove pebbles stuck in the sole
- · Wipe the boot with a dry cloth and air dry only
- DO NOT clean with harsh soap as this removes natural oils from the leather and makes it more rigid

General tips
